To prepare for Year 4

This picture on the left shows a 'Dream Tree'. You are going to be creating your own Dream Tree. You will design leaves which you can attach to a branch of a tree. The leaf will have goals which you want to achieve in Year 4 and how you are going to go about achieving them. These goals are personal to you as it has to be realistic to what YOU can successfully achieve, not somebody else.

Task - your task is to create your own Dream Tree.

You can draw a tree in your home learning book and draw leaves to hang off of each branch. However, if you have the time and resources, you may wish to use the 'leaf template' on the next page and decorate each leaf with your goals for Year 4. You can then make a tree trunk and branches out of any material you have, and cut out your leaves and stick them on.

When coming up with your goals, make sure to also explain how you are going to achieve them. You can illustrate your leaf however you would like. Remember there is no right or wrong answer, this is completely down to how YOU want to achieve your best next year!
