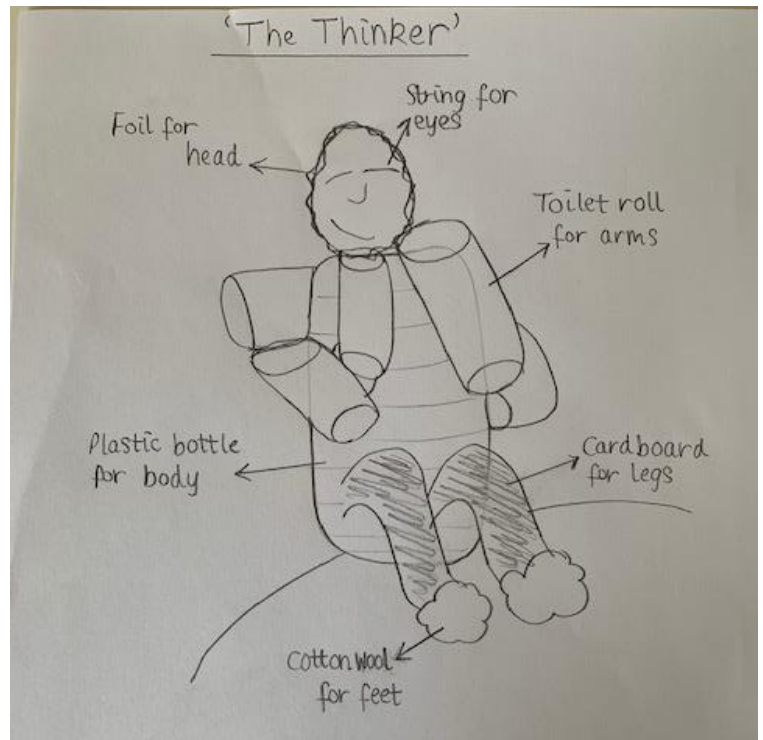
Today you are going to create your sculpture using the materials you identified in your plans last week.
