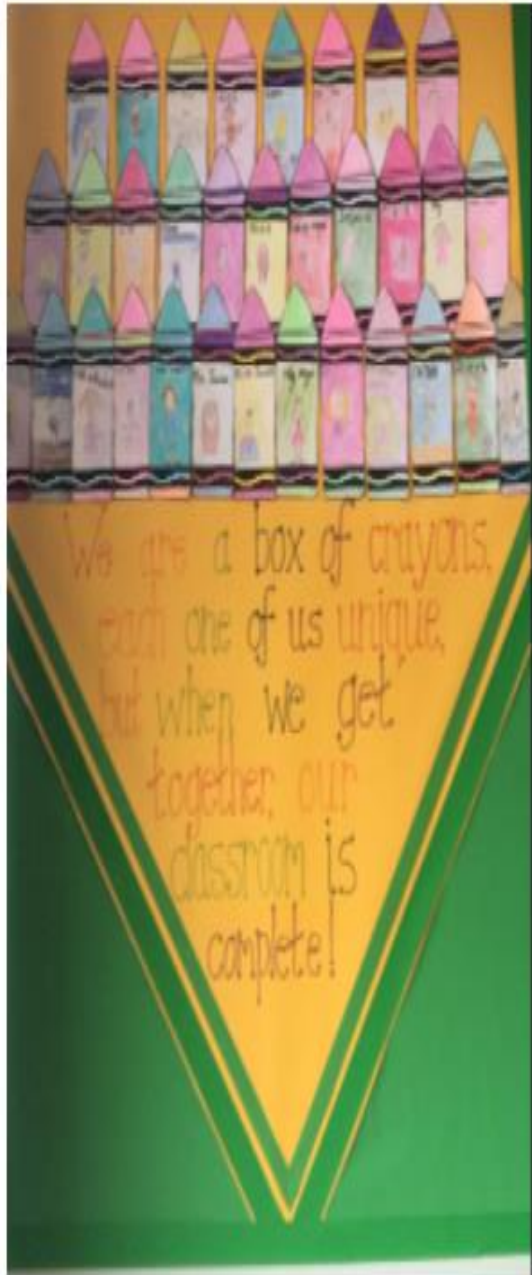
You are now Year 4 and should be helpful and set an example to Year 3. You should act as role models to them.

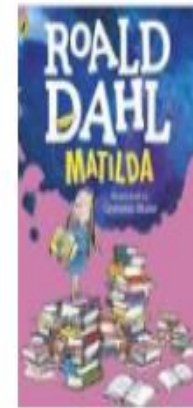
