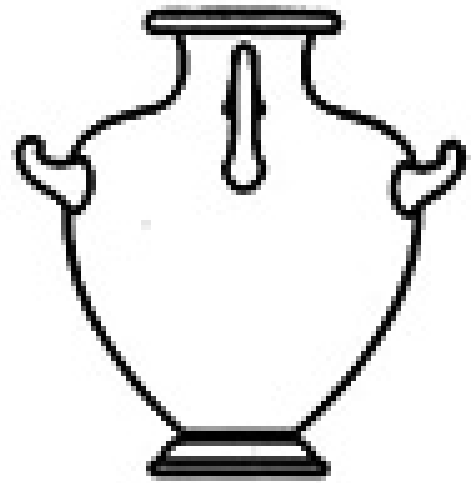
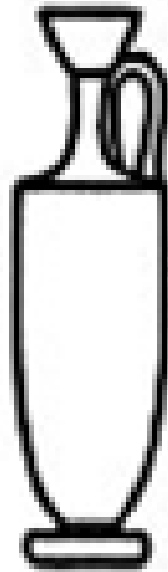
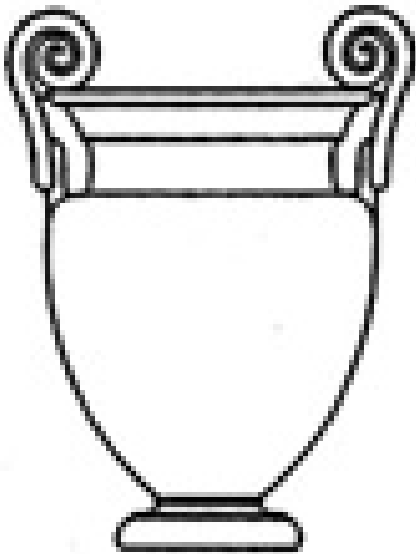


Designing an Ancient Greek inspired vase

This week, for your art learning, you are going to put everything you have learnt this half term about Ancient Greek vases into a final design. You can draw your work into your Home Learning books or onto a blank piece of paper.

Step One

Pick a style you liked. Make sure you draw it big (an entire A4 page or bigger) so that you have space for your design on the inside. There is a templates at the bottom if you would like to use that instead.



Step Two

Pick your favourite Greek God or Ancient Greek mythical beast and draw them on the inside. Remember to draw them big so you can add in some detail.

Medusa

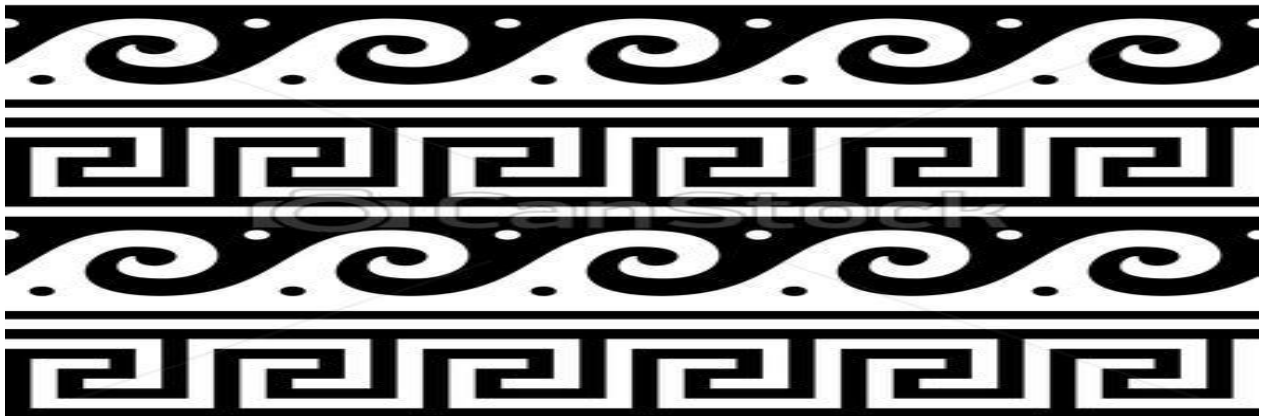


Pegasus

Now, add some patterns around the top and the bottom of your vase.

Step Four

Finally, if you can, add colour to your design. To make sure it looks like an Ancient Greek vase remember these common techniques used:

- The black figure technique (black figures on an orange-red background) with this technique, your figure will not have much detail.
- Red – figure (orangey-red figures on a black background) with this technique your figures will have detail in black.
- White- ground – (black, orange and red figures on a white background with black detail)

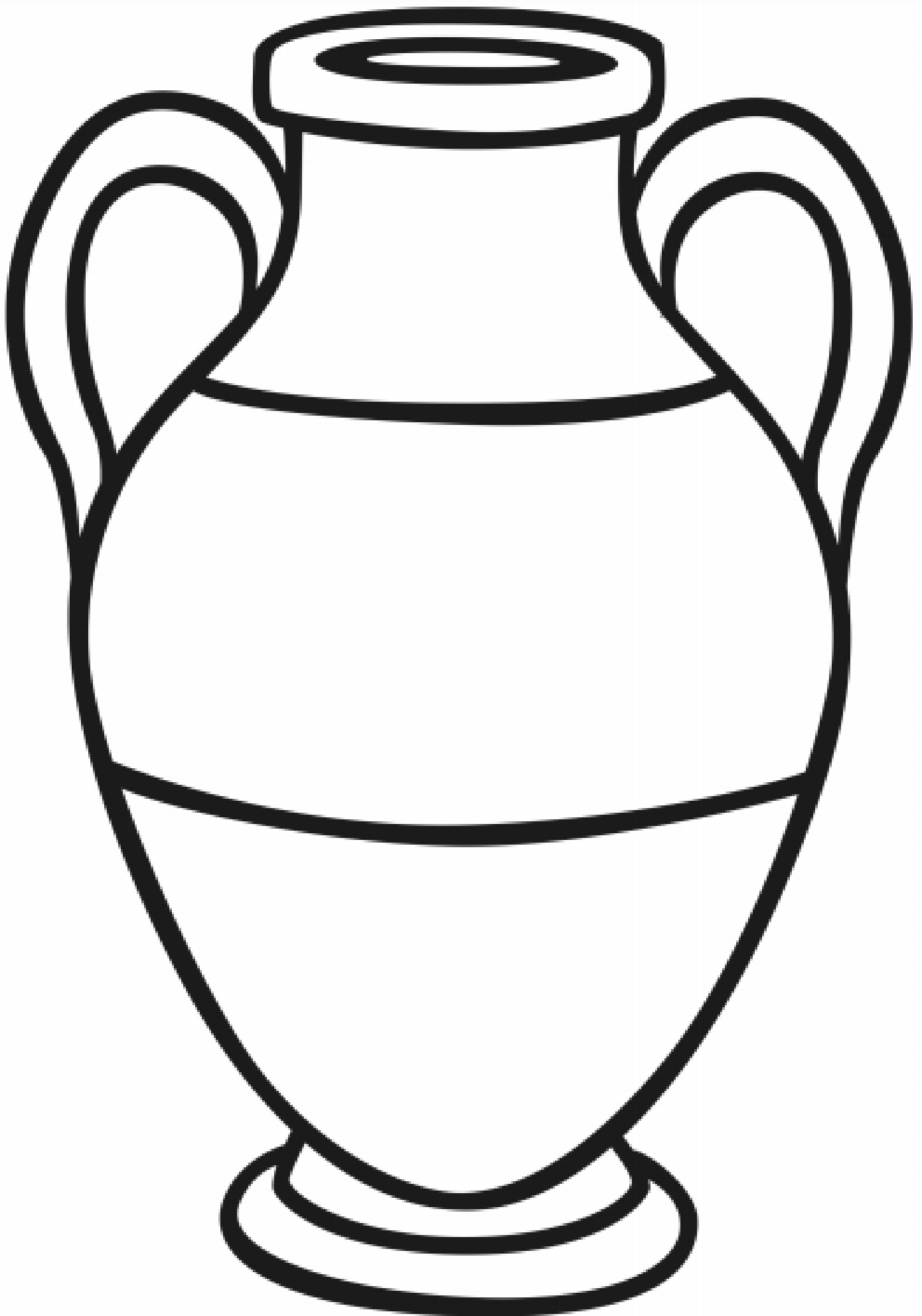
