<u>Paragraphs</u>	✓
<u>Beginning:</u> Who is your character? <i>Describe their personality and appearance</i>	
How do they get to the new world?	
What do they see, feel, hear and smell as they enter it?	
<u>Middle:</u> Who might they meet on their travels?	
What do they do / what happens to them in the new world?	
<u>Ending:</u> How do they get back to the world they came from?	

Success Criteria:

- emotive vocabulary to engage the reader
- varied sentence openers (DADWAVER)
- varied sentence lengths
- cohesive paragraphs
- range of punctuation
- third person
- past tense

Here's a reminder of DADWAVER:

Description, Action, Dialogue, Thought, Where, Adverb, Verb, Estimation of time, Rhetorical question
