

To use subordinate clauses

Task 1

What types of sentences are these (simple, compound, complex)?

A simple sentence uses just one clause, whereas a compound sentence uses two or more independent clauses. A complex sentence features at least a single independent clause as well as at least one dependent clause.

They are all complex sentences.

What do you notice about them?

They all have a subordinate clause in them.

What is a subordinate clause?

Why do we use them?

A subordinate clause is a group of words that contain a subject and a verb but it cannot stand on its own.

Subordinate clauses which are added to a main clause allow us to add detail and build up atmosphere in narratives.

What is the subordinate clause in each of the sentences above?

1. After thinking through his prospects, Kandinsky gave up the law at 30 years old and decided to become an artist.
2. Claude Monet, who was a French artist, was a true inspiration to Kandinsky.

3. Kandinsky felt he could express feelings and music through colours and shapes as his experience of painting grew.

Notice that the underlined red sections (subordinate clauses) do not make sense on their own.

What is a relative clause?

Relative clauses are a type of subordinate clause.

- They are embedded clauses
- They tell us more about the noun and start with relative pronouns

Relative pronouns are: who, which, that, whom, whose.

Find the relative pronoun in the sentences below.

- Wassily Kandinsky, who was born to a musician and tea merchant, grew up in Odessa.
- Abstract art, which formed the main form of modern art, uses shapes, colours and marks to achieve its effect.
