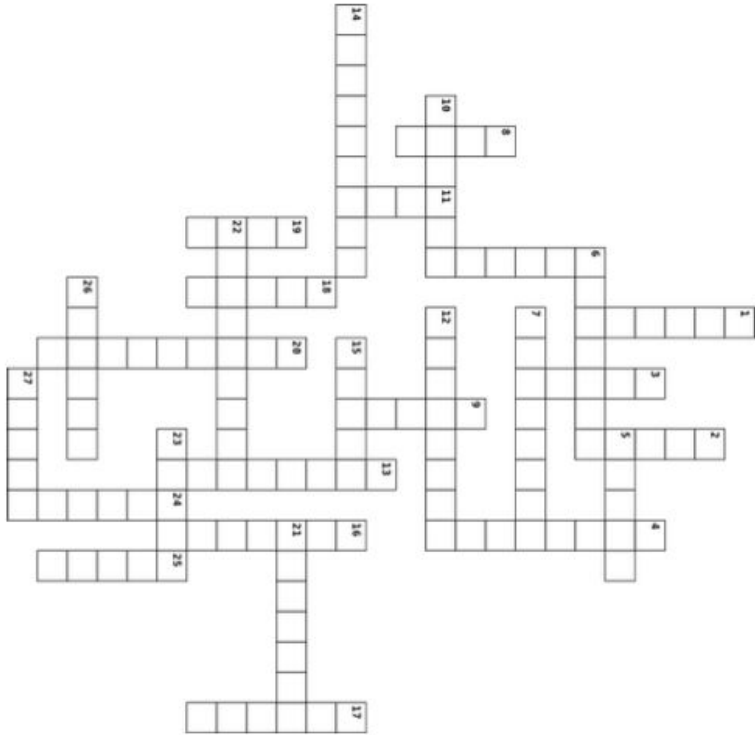

**Round 1 - General music**

**Name 3 woodwind instruments**

Answers could include: flute, oboe, bassoon, clarinet, piccolo bass clarinet, saxophone (soprano, alto, tenor, baritone), recorder, nose flute, kazoo!

**Name 3 brass instruments**

Answers could include: trumpet, trombone, french horn, tuba, euphonium, tenor horn, pbone, cornet, sousaphone, fanfare trumpet

**Name 3 stringed instruments**

violin, viola, cello, double bass, harp, guitar (acoustic / electric), ukulele, banjo, mandolin

**Name 3 percussion instruments**

Answers could include: drum (snare, bass, hand) djembe, bongos, congas, triangle, guiro, claves, maracas, tambourines, clatterpillar, cabassa, castanets, vibraslap, cymbals, piano, plus body, pencil cases and kitchen utensils!

**Name 3 standard orchestral instruments**

Answers could include: violin, viola, cello, double bass, trumpet, trombone, tuba, french horn, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, piccolo, bass clarinet, harp, timpani, claves, triangle, bass drum, snare drum, chimes, tubular bells, glockenspiel, xylophone,

**Name 3 singers**

Answers could include: this list is endless but should include you...!

**Name 3 musical elements**

Answers could include: pitch, pulse, rhythm, dynamics, tempo, melody, harmony, structure/form, texture, articulation

**Name 3 note values**

Answers could include: breve, semibreve, dotted minim, minim, crotchet, quaver, semiquaver, demi-semiquaver, dotted quaver, dotted crotchet, hemi-demi-semiquaver

**Name 3 styles of music**

Answers could include: Pop, Classical, Rock, Jazz, Hiphop, R&B, Blues, Rap, Musical Theatre, Soul, Funk, Reggae, Folk, Opera

**Name 3 classical composers**

Answers could include: Mozart, Haydn, Beethoven, Schubert, Rossini, Saint-Saens, Bizet, Brahm, Mussorgsky, Tchaikovsky, Dvorak, Elgar, Wagner

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Round 2 - Carnival of the Animals and The Proms

**Name 3 kitchen items that you could use to make into percussion**

Answers could include: saucepan, washing up bowl, chopstix, glasses, spoons / cutlery, bowl, bottles, baking tray

**Name 3 composers or pieces that have used fanfares**

Answers could include: Beethoven, Grazyna Bacewicz, John Williams, Copland, Olympic fanfare, Here comes the bride, Mendelsohn's wedding march, The last post & reverie, any TV or radio theme, most mobile ringtones

**Name 3 ways of writing down a musical composition**

Answers could include: as letters, as music notes (standard music notation), as rhythmic notation, a graphic score, using morse code,

**Name 3 composers, conductors, musicians or organisers connected to The Proms**

Answers could include: Sir Henry Wood, Robert Newman, Edward Elgar, Beethoven, Wagner, BBC Symphony Orchestra, Marian Alsop,

**Name 3 things traditionally found at the last night of the proms**

Answers could include: audience, orchestra, conductor, musicians, flags, union jacks, audience singing, canons, streamers, rule britannia, land of hope and glory, jerusalem,

**Name 3 musical instruments you enjoy playing or listening to**

Answers could include: absolutely anything musical!

**Name 3 bands or singers you enjoy listening to**

Answers could include: absolutely anyone - surprise me!

**Name 3 things Miss B has in her music room**

Answers could include: piano, union jack flags, union jack hat, metronome, frog guiro, whiteboard, whiteboard pens, Scratchy the cat, ukulele,
