- who they might meet on their travels,
- what they do / what happens to them in the new world,
- how they get back to the world they came from.

Read the extracts provided from Alice in Wonderland, The Indian in the Cupboard and The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe. You will find lots of ideas and vocabulary for you to magpie to inspire your own story.

It is important you use your own ideas too from other books and films (Gulliver's Travels, Harry Potter).
