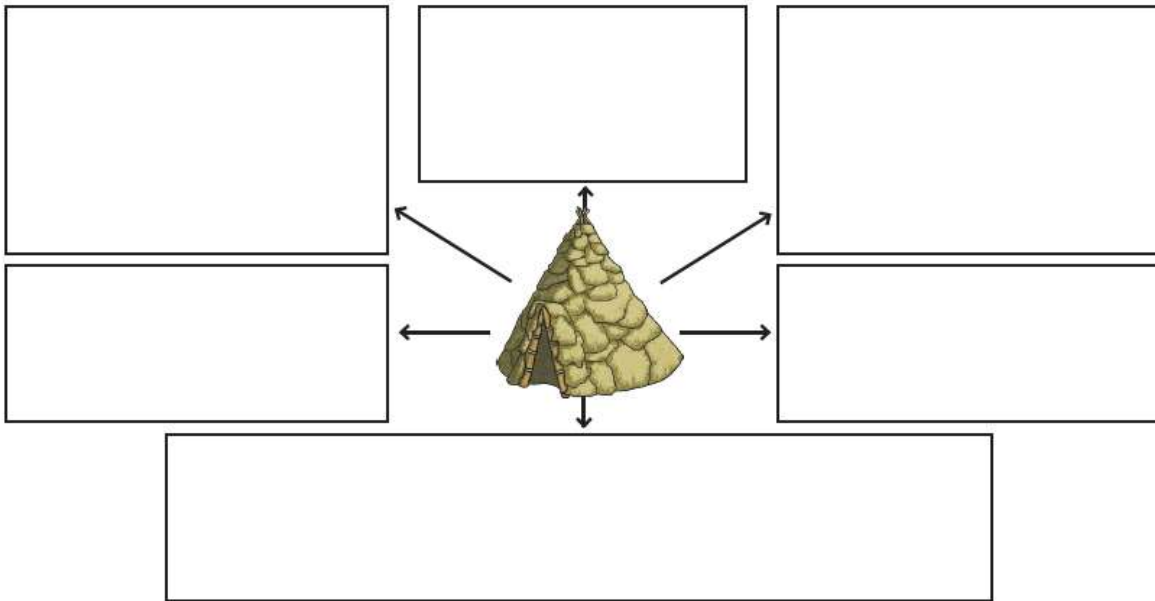

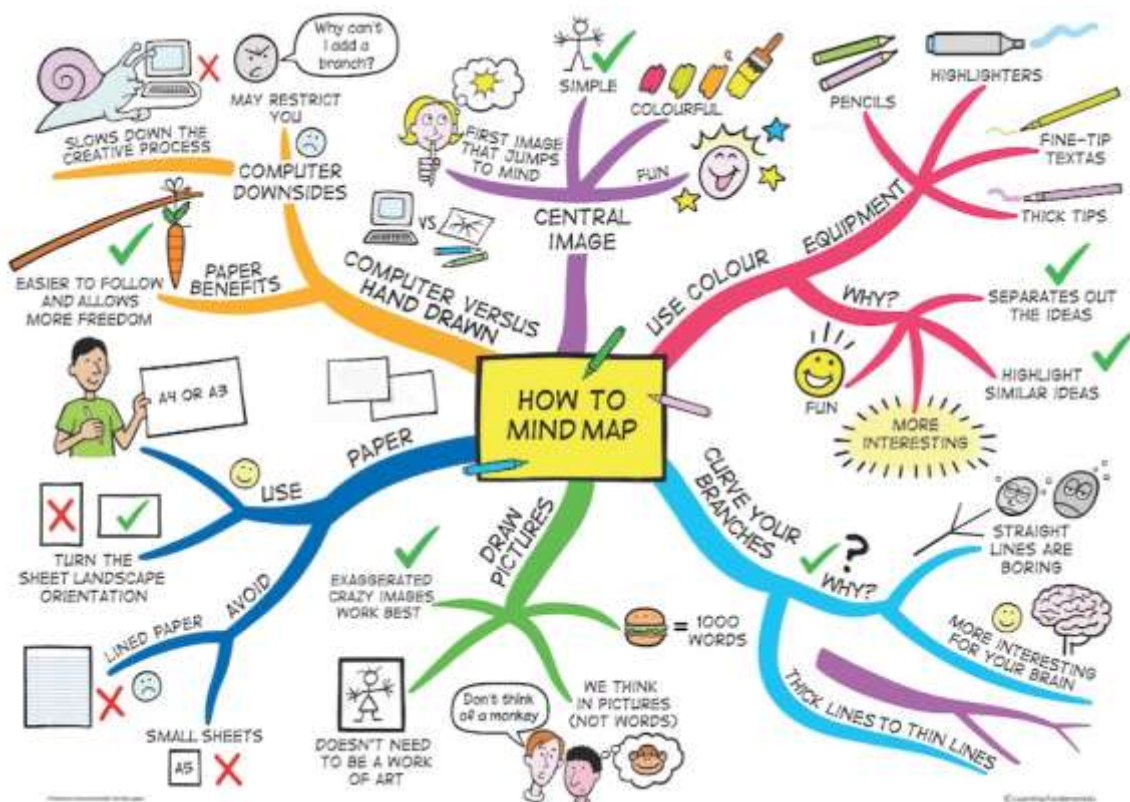
**Task 1- Revision:** Order these key events from oldest to most recent to create a timeline of the Stone Age period in your home learning books. You could draw a straight line across a double page spread and then plot these key events on the timeline in chronological order.

<p>13,000BC</p>  <p>People make cave paintings.</p>	<p>800-700BC</p>  <p>The first hill forts are made.</p>	<p>4,500-3,500BC</p>  <p>Farming starts and begins to spread.</p>
<p>100BC</p>  <p>Coins are made and used for the first time.</p>	<p>2,500BC</p>  <p>Metal starts to be used.</p>	<p>1,800BC</p>  <p>The first copper mines are dug.</p>
<p>1,200-800BC</p>  <p>Metal tools are made and used.</p>	<p>1,200-800BC</p>  <p>Tribal Kingdoms and celtic culture.</p>	<p>700-500BC</p>  <p>Iron is used a lot more than before.</p>
