Dear Parents/Carers

COVID UPDATED GUIDANCE:

Following new guidance from Barnet Public Health, these are the measures we ask families to take, to keep our school community safe:

- Please carry out regular lateral flow tests on Sunday and Wednesday evenings at the least.
- If someone in the family has a positive result, all those in contact are strongly advised to take a PCR test and not to attend school while waiting for the result. Keep the school informed on welfare@gsjs@barnetmail.net
- If we have a positive case in a class, we will inform parents in the class and ask them to carry out lateral flow tests with the family and to repeat these more frequently for 10 days. Your children are still allowed to attend school if these tests are negative and they are symptom free.
- If your child develops any symptoms OR has a positive lateral flow test, you should request a PCR test immediately, and they should not attend school until they have a negative result.

Health and Safety Notice: Safe Parking

Thank you to the parent volunteers who monitor the parking on the Willifield slip road. We also have our 'Little People' signs to discourage parking in this area. It was disappointing to hear that a member of our community ignored the signs and was extremely impolite to our volunteers this week. It is never acceptable to park in the area around the car park and the footpath, even if you are late! We have children who travel alone who are put in danger if you park or drive in this area at drop off and pick up times.
