Dear Parents/Carers

COVID-19

We have had three positive PCR tests this week and are awaiting the results of three more tests. We are only able to get further guidance from the DfE if these tests are positive. I will update you as soon as possible if there is any further action we need to take.

This really highlights the importance of doing regular lateral flow tests twice a week at least. If the test is positive, or if anyone has symptoms of cough and temperature, a PCR test should then be carried out to confirm the result and the school kept informed throughout the process. Whilst waiting for the result of the PCR test children should remain at home until they get the result and they feel well enough to come to school.

Children have been acting out games in the playground from a violent programme on Netflix called Squid Game
Parents should check that their children do not have access to this programme. The programme features characters
competing in a series of games where failure results in death.

Snacks in School

Children should only bring fresh fruit or vegetable for their mid-morning snack. We are noticing that children are bringing a variety of inappropriate items. Please support our school policy on snacks and ensure that your child is not breaking the school rules.
