# Tests Helps to Keep Our Community Safe

We now expect all children to have a lateral flow test before they come to school every day.

If your child has any Covid symptoms, you must request a full PCR test and not send them in to school until you have a negative result back. We have a busy, fun few weeks ahead of us and we don't want to have to cancel any of the upcoming events.

Please ensure you have a stock of lateral flow tests at home so you can continue to test regularly. ### Assemblies and Curriculum Events

We put great effort in to developing the cultural capital of the children through our broad curriculum.

- > Anti-bullying Week: The theme of assemblies this week was celebrating diversity and accepting differences.
- Year 3 Drama Workshops: Workshops took place today called 'Hidden Figures Black and British'. The children learnt fascinating stories of brilliant Black people, often omitted from our history lessons, who have shaped our country. These 'hidden figures' were used to entertain and inform discussions to give an insight into our history; a history that includes Black people as fundamental to creating the fabric of our society and the rich tapestry of who we are today.
- Year 5 Drama Workshops: The children enjoyed workshops in the morning where they met one of Henry VIII's wives, Catherine Parr, and learnt about the life of a soldier in Tudor Times. In the afternoon they had a visit from Henry VIII and learnt more about his many wives. The children experience Tudor music and dance and thoroughly enjoyed dressing up in Tudor costumes for the day. Well done everyone!
- Year 4 Virtual Tour of Houses of Parliament: The Year 4 children enjoyed a virtual tour of the Houses of Parliament today where they experienced an interactive presentation explaining how the House of Lords and House of Commons worked. They learnt how bills become laws. Finally, they took part in a mock debate.
- Football: The boys' team took part in a league match against Brooklands school and won 3-0. A mixed team also took part in a friendly match and drew 2-2. Well done everyone!
