Garden Suburb Governors could be just what you're looking for. We are a federated governing body, jointly serving both the Infant and Junior schools. We are made up of parents, former parents, businesspeople, professionals, educators, and members of our wider community. There is no such thing as a "typical governor", and if you care about our schools, we want to hear from you.

We are currently looking for two Parent Governors (one for the Infants and one for the Juniors). Parent Governors are elected by all the parents in each school, to serve on the Garden Suburb Governing Body for four years. Parent Governors have exactly the same status and responsibilities as every other governor, along with bringing a parent's perspective to our discussions and decisions.

Being a governor means attending six evening meetings a year. You would also be a member of two committees, and attend six morning meetings a year. Since the pandemic, we have continued to hold our meetings virtually over Zoom, which helps us fit around family, work and other commitments.
