Assemblies and curriculum Events

- The importance of politeness and respect was focused on in assemblies this week.
- **Year 6 visited Kenwood House in Hampstead:** On Wednesday. Victoria Gordon, from English Heritage, delivered an engaging talk, about the importance of Lord Mansfield and his great niece Dido Belle and its complicated link to slavery in Georgian times. The children had the opportunity to look at a range of paintings depicting the family and also explore the grounds. With a focus on Black History Month, stereotypes of that time were considered and how Dido Belle's presence impacted her uncle's Justice of the King's Bench. They enjoyed challenging the ethics of the time and were passionate about the mansion house, asking lots of interesting questions.
- **Y5 workshops 'Quest for Windrush':** This work supported the focus on Black History that Year 5 are studying this term. The children recreated the journey from Jamaica to England, from packing suitcases and saying goodbye to loved ones to boarding the ship with Lord Kitchener. The children explored the difficulties of finding a room and working in a foreign, and not necessarily friendly, country. The children gained an in-depth knowledge of the topic and explored both the emotional and practical aspects of migration.
- House captains led house assemblies today with a focus on introducing themselves and promoting our 'Learning Powers'.

Mid-Morning/After School Snacks

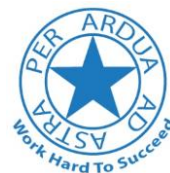
