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Assemblies and curriculum Events

- ➤ **Disability Awareness/ Jeans for Genes Day:** Thank you everyone for contributing to our charity collection. The children learnt about the work the charity does to support research into genetic disorders. Ask your child what DNA stands for.

 - **Travel Ambassadors:** Promote walking and carbon neutral travelling, take part in special projects eg creating a map of walking routes, introducing competitions and judging them
 - Book Worms: Promoting reading and monitoring reading areas in the classrooms
