Barnet's Active and Creative Holidays (BACE) Information Winter 2023/2024

Bookings are now live for parents and carers to apply for places for children and young people to attend our BACE holiday camps.

We know the school holidays can be challenging for some parents and carers because of work and other commitments. Our holiday club provides a range of activities from sports to performing arts and much more for children and young people from the ages of Reception to Y11 (4-16). All children also receive a healthy free meal during the day.

To attend the holiday camp, children and young people must be registered to receive benefits related free school meals and need to use the 16-digit e-voucher code provided by the school to apply for a place. All spaces are funded through the department for education.

Parents and carers not eligible for BACE camps can access our Positive Activities Holiday Provision, funded by the council, for all children and young people who attend a school or live in the Borough of Barnet.
