Safer Internet day Tuesday 6th February – See guidance for parents attached

On Tuesday 6th February we will be joining schools and youth organisations across the UK in celebrating Safer Internet Day 2024.

Safer Internet Day is a global campaign to promote the safe and responsible use of technology, which calls on young people, parents, carers, teachers, social workers, law enforcement, companies, policymakers and more, to help to create a better internet.

This year the campaign will be focusing on change online, this includes covering:

- Young people's perspective on new and emerging technology
- Using the internet to make change for the better
- The changes young people want to see online
- The things that can influence and change the way young people think, feel and act online and offline

Using the internet safely and positively is a key message that we promote in Garden Suburb Junior School, and celebrating Safer Internet Day is a great opportunity for us to re-emphasise the online safety messages we deliver throughout the year.

We would be delighted if you could join us in celebrating the day by continuing the conversation at home. 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Measles

Measles is rising in London. MMR vaccine rates are still worryingly low in Barnet. Protect your children against measles. Measles is a viral illness that can be serious and sometimes fatal. Cases of measles are rising in London, and with around 73% of 5-year-olds fully vaccinated in Barnet, we are well below the World Health Organisations target of 95% needed to prevent an outbreak.

Symptoms of measles include high fever, runny nose, cough, red and watery eyes, small red spots with a bluish-white centre inside the mouth. A rash can appear later, usually on the face, upper neck, hands and feet. Vaccination can help prevent outbreaks and protect against serious illness. Any child identified as a close contact of a measles case without satisfactory vaccination status may be asked to self-isolate for up to 21 days.

Download this <u>childhood immunisations leaflet</u> (translations available), explaining which vaccine to get and when. Check your child's red book and contact their GP to make sure they are up to date on their routine vaccinations. If you're 18-25 and you think you've not had the MMR vaccine, please check with your GP.

If your child has missed the vaccine as a baby or pre-schooler, contact your child's GP to make an appointment or visit a <u>catch up clinic</u>.
