GPS stands for Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.

To reach the national standard at the end of Key Stage 2, you must achieve a scaled score of 100.

The average scaled score in Reading at GSJS was 107.

The average scaled score in Maths at GSJS was 109.

The average scaled score in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling at GSJS was 110.

There is no pass mark or expected standard threshold for the MTC. It is intended that schools use their own judgement. We have created our own grade boundaries and data analysis below.
