Dear Parents/Carers

'The Sustainable Seasonal Fair' is on Friday 5th December.

Thank you to those of you who have made donations for the Seasonal Fair. We are asking you to donate approximately 8 items in good condition for sale at the Seasonal Fair.

We will be collecting until **Thursday 4th December**.

Please make every effort to donate. This is an event that the children enjoy very much!

Some parents have requested if they can donate money instead of gifts. However, we are trying to reduce the jobs that our hardworking PTA have to do, in order to provide these lovely events for your children. To reduce their workload, we are really happy for parents to purchase new items (instead of donating money) if parents prefer to do this.

Reminder: Baking for the Seasonal Fair

This year the PTA is planning a festive biscuit stall at the seasonal fair. This is a stand where children can buy a small bag of homemade biscuits (usually 3 biscuits per bag), for £1.

It is always a popular stand! In order to make sure no child is disappointed, the PTA try to ensure that there are enough bags of biscuits so that should every child wants to purchase one, they can. In practice, that means 330 bags of biscuits (and at 3 per bag, that's 990 biscuits to bake!) The PTA is therefore calling all willing bakers to please volunteer to help!

Remember to get some cash ready for your child to spend at the fair!


The fair is during the morning and is a wonderful fundraising event!

2. **A bag** with their name on to carry their purchases





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

- Y3 Stop Motion Workshops:** Y3 had an exciting visit from a Discovery Educator last week who introduced the children to the magic of stop-motion animation. The children learnt how to plan a sequence, take frame-by-frame photos, and bring everyday objects to life using digital tools. - Y5 Hampton Court visit:** This engaging trip supported the Y5 children’s learning on the Tudors
- ‘Talk on Tuesday’** is an initiative to encourage discussion. The theme this week is:
Do you think it is easier to be a child or an adult? Why?
 We have asked the children to have discussions at home and they can then feedback in their classes. Please encourage your child to discuss the theme, for example with the family at dinner time.
- Travel Ambassadors:** Well done to our Explorer Ambassadors for hosting an assembly to launch our 'Be Bright, Be Seen' campaign. They reminded the school about how to stay visible in the darker winter months and about how to stay safe on the roads as a pedestrian. This week and next, children will be decorating bags in classes during golden time, using florescent and reflective materials to make them more visible. The top entry from each class will be sent to Barnet Council to be judged.

Understand and managing emotion regulation: Monday 1st December

This session will help parents/carers understand more about what causes dysregulated emotions, and how to support children and young people on improving their emotional literacy. It will teach parents healthy emotion regulation strategies they can model to support the wellbeing of their children.

Understanding and Managing Anxiety: Wednesday 3rd December at 9:00am in the Infant School Hall

This presentation will have a particular focus on children with neuro-diversity including autism, specific learning difficulties and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder.

Managing challenging behaviour: Monday 15th December

This session will provide parents and caregivers a chance to understand some of the causes of difficult behaviour and how to bring about positive behaviour. This includes learning how to give effective instructions, selective listening, praise, and rewards.

Seasonal 'Thank You' to our Support Staff



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Arbor– Keep informed!

If you need any help activating or logging in to your account, please contact the school office as soon as possible: admin@gsjs.barnetmail.net.

Newsletters will be sent electronically **every Friday by email** - please look out for them! Arbor is used for all other communication from the school, including emergency messages regarding school closures etc., either by text, or by email. It is your responsibility to keep your Arbor account updated with any contact detail changes. ***Please remember to also notify the school office with changes in contact details for our own records system.***

Lone Travellers - Parents need to complete a 'Lone Travelling' form if children are travelling to or from school without an adult. **This is only permitted for Y5 and Y6 pupils.** All Y5 and Y6 children will bring home a Lone Traveller form to complete on Tuesday. Forms can be requested from Mrs Alvares welfare@gsjs.barnetmail.net if arrangements change throughout the year.

Mobile Phones

Most schools now are **not** allowing pupils to bring in mobile phones for safeguarding reasons. Exceptional circumstances will be considered for Y5/Y6 pupils and a request should be put in writing using our 'Mobile Phone Parental Request Form'. Smart phones with cameras and access to the internet will not be permitted.
